To pass this TESOL-TTC program, each teacher-trainee has to successfully complete the following tasks for both parts (A & B) of the program:

Part A

- Attends 50 hours of workshops, 2 hours a day, 5 days a week, 5 weeks.
- Presents selected readings from the textbooks assigned for the program.
- Watches professionally designed teacher-training videos made by International House London and other teacher-training videos, discusses such videos and completes the accompanying video tasks.
- Conducts micro-teachings to apply the theoretical information learned from the assigned textbooks, the teaching techniques learned from the teacher-training videos and the discussions of such videos.
- Learns and practices writing final exams and reader quizzes.
- Does at least three classroom observations and writes a separate observation report for each.
- Attends placement testing with academic coordinators of TESOL programs to learn how students are tested and placed in different levels in the institution where the TESOL-TTC program is held.

Part B

- Each teacher-trainee is assigned a 50-hour class for which he/she prepares lessons, teaches and evaluates students during and at the end of the term under the teacher trainer's supervision.
- Each teacher-trainee is observed by the teacher-trainer 3 - 5 times during his/her teaching practice.
- The teacher-trainee gets immediate oral feedback for 15 - 30 minutes from the trainer after each observation.
- For each observation, the teacher-trainee gets a written observation report in which feedback is given to illustrate the teacher-trainee's strengths and challenges before the following observation takes place.
- Once the teacher trainee completes this part successfully, he/she completes the program and receives a certificate of completion.
